

## We are transforming education in Latin America and the Caribbean through **School Leadership**

**School leadership** is directly connected to improvement in student learning outcomes, is extremely cost effective and empowers communities that engage with schools.

## We are creating the first School Leadership Regional Hub

The hub groups **organizations that are currently working in school leadership,** helping them increase their impact in the region.

### Our journey so far

Mapped organizations and local networks.

Select organisation working on school leadership in the region.

We started with 5 countries and selected organisations: Centro Lemann, Coppel, Educando, Empresarios por la educación, Enseña Perú, y Varkey Foundation

O2 Conducted research on the Latin American context, identifying challenges for school leadership. Challenges identified include:

- Influence of political changes
- Decentralization of education systems
- Tests do not reflect leadership effectiveness
- Difficult work conditions, low autonomy and high expectations for SL
- Differences in national frameworks and schools' reality
- Diverse and unclear career trajectory

## Our journey so far

Co-design a first proposal in collaboration with 25 organisations from 15 countries, establishing the hub's purpose, values, objectives and model.

Design of a final proposal for the regional hub, integrating all the data collected through the research and the workshops with organisations.

# These consultations have provided **positive feedback** on this initiative, demonstrating strong support for collective action.

The path forward is clear: to foster meaningful and lasting change, collaboration, knowledge exchange, and country-specific contextualization are critical.

## Purpose & vision



#### Our purpose

To elevate school leadership as a cornerstone for improving the quality and equity of education across Latin America and the Caribbean, by generating tools, knowledge, and strategies that lead to systemic change.

**And vision** - To become the go-to regional network for school leadership, building evidence that professionalizes and empowers school leaders to drive transformation in education.

Development

The hub will foster collaboration through co-creation spaces, capacity-building initiatives, and annual regional publications, strengthening the network of school leaders. Some initiatives include:

- a. Quarterly member meetings
- b. Immersion trips
- c. Theme-based working groups
- d. Open resource library

## The opportunity

Key area #4
Advocacy for
Systemic Change

We aim to influence national education policies, positioning school leadership as a key driver of long-term transformation. Initiative include:

- a. Ready-to-use material for advocacy
- b. Open webinars with diverse stakeholders

We aim to create a collaborative and open network that allows its members to actively engage with the hub and its initiatives.

Members will be at the center of the hub, making decision through an elected rotative committee and guiding the hubs strategic decisions.

## Membership



#### Who can be a member?

Organizations with a **focus on education and a particular interest in School Leadership** are eligible to join.

Country ambassadors will play a key role in building local coalitions and expanding membership by including organizations from diverse perspectives.

The goal is to create **heterogeneous coalitions capable of developing a shared agenda**, bridging the regional initiatives of the hub to actionable outcomes at the national level.
